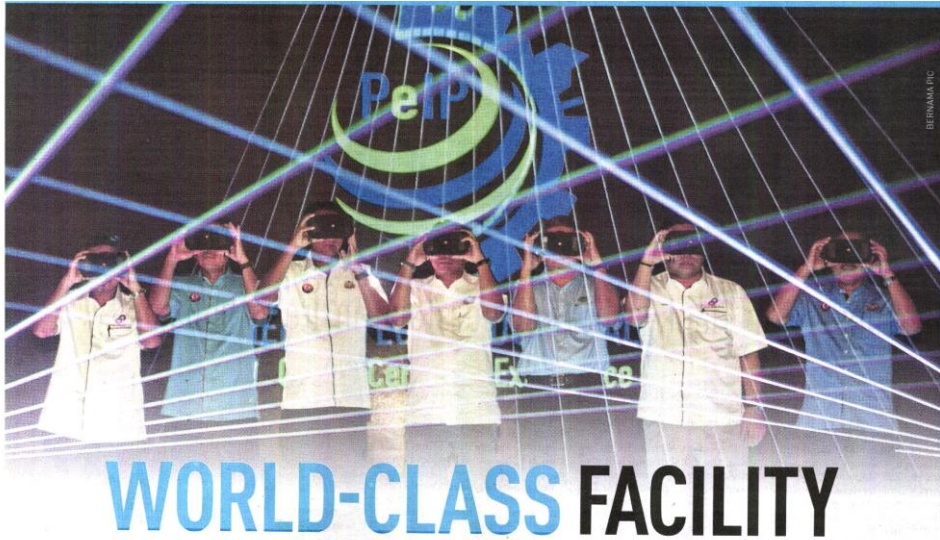

# SERBA DINAMIK TO JOINTLY DEVELOP PEIP

Country's first MRO and IRM Centre of Excellence will support O&G companies

**S**ERBA Dinamik Holdings Bhd will develop Malaysia's first maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO) and inspection, repair and maintenance (IRM) Global Centre of Excellence for the oil and gas (O&G) industry for RM1.5 billion.

The development here, known as Pengerang Eco Industrial Park (PEIP), will also boast a plant turnaround village as well as a technical and vocational education and training city.

Serba Dinamik will jointly develop the PEIP with Perisind Samudra Sdn Bhd.

PEIP is the latest multi-billion investment that will support O&G companies in Pengerang.

The 26ha development would be undertaken in three phases, said Menteri Besar Datuk Mohamed Khaled Nordin at the project's ground-breaking, here, yesterday.

"The first phase, with a gross development cost of RM1 billion, is expected to be completed in two years."

Serba Dinamik managing director Datuk Dr Mohd Abdul Karim Abdullah said the project would start with the construction of the plant turnaround village, followed by the MRO and IRM Global Centre of Excellence and technical and vocational education and training city.

He said the plant turnaround village would be equipped with modern machinery and facilities that could detect defects at the early stage to ensure safety and operational efficiency.

"The MRO and IRM Global Centre of Excellence will incorporate superior infrastructure to meet the needs of world-class players in the O&G and petrochemical industries," he added.

On another matter, a business daily reported that Serba Dinamik was finalising talks on a potential acquisition of a United States firm.

"It should be completed this year," Karim was quoted as saying.

Serba Dinamik's order book stands at RM6.2 billion currently and it is targeting an order book of RM7.5 billion this year.
